BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS.

Do you have your own business or are you looking to start a new business? For those that already have a current business license you will receive a license renewal form during the month of December. Please review and complete the renewal form. For those that would like to start a new business, please refer to Title 3 of our online code at morgancityut.com. Title 3 of Morgan City Code will direct you to what is required in order to conduct business in Morgan City and the process for a business license. For example, the following are descriptions in this section of the code:

BUSINESS: Means and includes all activities engaged in within the city carried on for the purpose of gain or economic profit.

ENGAGING IN BUSINESS: Includes, but is not limited to, the sale of tangible personal property at retail or wholesale, the manufacturing of goods or property and the rendering of personal services for others for a consideration by persons engaged in any profession, trade, craft, business, occupation or other calling, except the rendering of personal services by an employee to his employer under any contract of personal employment.

Morgan City dog owners are required to renew their dog license's annually.

Please bring in your animal's current rabies certificate.
