## Notice of Election

Pursuant to Utah Election Code 20a-5-101(2)(a), I hereby give notice of the offices to be voted on in Morgan County, Utah at the upcoming General Election to be held on Tuesday, November 6, 2012. The candidate filing period will begin Friday, March 9, 2012 and ends at 5:00 p.m., Thursday, March 15, 2012.

1. Federal
  - a. President and Vice President for a four (4) year term.
  - b. U.S. House of Representatives. One representative for a two (2) year term in each of the following U.S. Congressional Districts.

First District. The First Congressional District is located in Box Elder, Cache, Daggett, Davis, Duchesne, Morgan, Rich, Summit, Uintah and Weber Counties.

2. State
  - a. **State Executive.** Each position will be elected for a four (4) year term.
    - (1) Governor
    - (2) Lieutenant Governor
    - (3) Attorney General
    - (4) State Auditor
    - (5) State Treasurer
  - b. **Senate.** One member for a four (4) year term from each of the following state senate districts. District Nineteen (19) is located in Morgan, Summit and Weber Counties.
  - c. **House of Representatives.** One member of the Utah House of Representatives for a two (2) year term from each of the seventy-five (75) state legislative districts.
3. County
  - a. **County Council.** One member for a four (4) year term from each of the following Morgan County Council Districts.

(1) **District Three (3)** Beginning at a point where the centerline of Dalton Creek and the centerline of the Weber River intersect, and running thence South along the centerline of the Weber River to the confluence of the Weber River and East Canyon Creek. Thence South along the centerline of East Canyon Creek to a point where said centerline intersects the Morgan City boundary. Thence along the West and South Morgan City Boundaries to the coincident corner of said boundary and the intersection of the line between Townships 3 North and 4 North and the line between Ranges 2 East and 3 East. Thence East along the line between Townships 3 North and 4 North to the East County boundary. Thence South, thence West, and thence North along the County boundary to a point where the Westerly extension of the Right Hand Fork of Dalton Creek intersects the County boundary. Thence along said extension to the centerline of the Right Hand Fork of Dalton Creek, and thence East along the centerline of the Right Hand Fork of Dalton Creek and the centerline of Dalton Creek to the intersection of the centerline of Dalton Creek and the centerline of the Weber River, the point of beginning.

(2) **District Four (4)** Beginning at a point where the centerline of the Weber River and the centerline of East Canyon Creek intersect, and running thence Southeast along the Weber River to a point where the centerline of the Weber River intersects the centerline of 200 East Street in Morgan City. Thence South along the centerline of 200 East Street to a point where the centerline of said street intersects the centerline of 100 South Street. Thence West along 100 South Street approximately 225 feet to the boundary line between two parcels having the following serial numbers: 04-035-001 and 04-035-013. Thence South between said parcels and continuing along the extension of that line between additional parcels to the North boundary of the Deer Hollow Subdivision at lot 12 of said subdivision. Thence following the boundary of the Deer Hollow Subdivision West, thence South, thence East, thence South to the Southernmost point of said subdivision, thence Northeast to a point where the boundary of said subdivision intersects the center-Section line of Section 36 Township 4 North Range 2 East. Thence South along said center-Section line to the boundary of the Morgan City South cemetery. Thence along the boundary of said cemetery East, thence South to the line between Townships 3 North and 4 North and the Morgan City Boundary. Thence, West along the South boundary of Morgan City and North along the West boundary of Morgan City to a point where said boundary intersects with the centerline of East Canyon Creek. Thence Northwest along the centerline of East Canyon Creek to a point at the confluence of East Canyon Creek and the Weber River where the centerlines of said creek and river intersect, the point of beginning.

(3) **One (1)** At Large position

4. School Board
  - a. **State School Board.** One member will be elected from District One (1) for a two (2) year term. District One (1) is located in Box Elder, Cache, Morgan, Rich and Weber Counties.
  - b. **Local School Board.** One board member for a four (4) year term from each of the following districts.
    - (1) **District One (1)** Beginning at a point where the line between Townships

4 North and 5 North intersect the Western County boundary, and running thence North and thence East along the County boundary to a point along the County boundary in Section 10 Township 5 North Range 2 East where a dirt road intersects the County boundary. Thence West and South along said dirt road to the centerline of Cottonwood Canyon Road. Thence Southwest along the centerline of Cottonwood Canyon Road, and including all houses that face onto said road, to the intersection of Cottonwood Canyon Road and Garnet Drive. Thence South along Garnet Drive, including all houses that face onto said road, to the intersection of Garnet Drive and Old Highway Road. Thence along the centerline of Old Highway Road to the Peterson exit road otherwise known as 4300 North Street, and East along the centerline of 4300 North Street to its intersection with Morgan Valley Drive. Thence due West to the line between Ranges 1 East and 2 East, thence North along said line to the line between Townships 4 North and 5 North, thence West along said Township line to the County boundary and the point of beginning.

(2) **District Three (3)** Beginning at a point where the centerline of Dalton Creek and the centerline of the Weber River intersect, and running thence South along the centerline of the Weber River to the confluence of the Weber River and East Canyon Creek. Thence South along the centerline of East Canyon Creek to a point where said centerline intersects the Morgan City boundary. Thence along the West and South Morgan City Boundaries to the coincident corner of said boundary and the intersection of the line between Townships 3 North and 4 North and the line between Ranges 2 East and 3 East. Thence East along the line between Townships 3 North and 4 North to the East County boundary. Thence South, thence West, and thence North along the County boundary to a point where the Westerly extension of the Right Hand Fork of Dalton Creek intersects the County boundary. Thence along said extension to the centerline of the Right Hand Fork of Dalton Creek, and thence East along the centerline of the Right Hand Fork of Dalton Creek and the centerline of Dalton Creek to the intersection of the centerline of Dalton Creek and the centerline of the Weber River, the point of beginning.

(3) **District Five (5)** Beginning at a point where the centerline of the Weber River and the centerline of Stoddard Lane intersect, and running thence East along the centerline of Stoddard Lane to its intersection with Old Highway Road. Thence South along Old Highway Road to the extension of the extension of the West boundary of the Patterson Pointe Subdivision, thence running North and Northeast along said extension and the boundary of the Patterson Pointe Subdivision. Thence North along the Western boundary of the Hidden Hollow Subdivision to the Section line between Sections 22 and 15 Township 4 North Range 2 East. Thence East along said Section line to its intersection with the line between Ranges 2 East and 3 East. Thence North along said Range line to its intersection with the County boundary. Thence Northeast, thence Southeast, and thence South West along the County boundary to its intersection with the line between Townships 3 North and 4 North. Thence West along said Township line to its intersection with the Morgan City boundary and the boundary of the Morgan City South cemetery. Thence North thence West along said boundary of the Morgan City South cemetery to the center-Section line of Section 36 Township 4 North Range 2 East. Thence North along said center-Section line to the boundary of the Deer Hollow Subdivision. Thence Southwest along said boundary to its Southernmost point, thence North, thence West, and thence North along said boundary. Thence East along said boundary of the Deer Hollow Subdivision to a point where said boundary intersects the extension of a line between two parcels with the following serial numbers: 04-035-001 and 04-035-013 at lot 12 of the Deer Hollow Subdivision. Thence North along said extension line and the boundary between the said parcels to the centerline of 100 South Street. Thence East approximately 225 feet along said centerline to its intersection with the centerline of 200 East Street. Thence North along the centerline of 200 East Street to its intersection with the centerline of the Weber River. Thence Northwest along the centerline of the Weber River to its intersection with the centerline of Stoddard Lane, the point of beginning.

5. Judicial
  - a. **Court of Appeals.** There will be an unopposed retention election for one (1) Court of Appeals Judge, provided that the incumbent whose term is expiring files during the filing period.
  - b. **District Court.** There will be a retention election for seventeen (17) District Court Judges in the following districts, provided that the incumbent(s) whose term is expiring files during the filing period:
    - Second District. Five (5) Judges in the Second Judicial District, which is located in Davis, Morgan, and Weber Counties.
    - c. **Juvenile Court.** There will be a retention election for seven (7) Juvenile Court Judges in the following districts provided that the incumbent(s) files during the filing period.
      - Second District. One (1) Judge in the Second Judicial District, which is located in Davis, Morgan and Weber Counties.
